



9TH ANNUAL ROEBLING'S 5K RUN/WALK

Seeking political and religious freedom, John A. Roebling emigrated to the U.S. from Germany and founded the small settlement of Germania, later known as Saxonburg, PA. There, in a small workshop, he developed wire rope used in his design and construction of the Brooklyn Bridge.

**This race is the second in the "Saxonburg Distance Series."
Cross Country Crusade 5K – July 18th; Saxonburg Festival of the Arts 5K – Sept. 12th**

- Course:** Rolling out and back course that starts / finishes at Knoch Senior High School.
- Awards:** Top 3 male and female finishers. Top 3 male and female Masters (40 & up). Top 3 male and female in each age group. No duplication.
- Series Awards:** Runners who pre-register and complete all races in the Saxonburg Distance Series are eligible for Series Awards. Top male and female. Top male and female Masters (40 & up). Male and female age group winners. Awards will be presented immediately following the Saxonburg Festival of the Arts 5K race.
- Age Groups:** 9 & under, 10–14, 15–19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75 & up. *For all three races age will be as of July 18, 2009*
- Entry Fees:** \$15 if mailed before August 1st. \$18 thereafter. \$45 to pre-register for all races in the series. Race day registration and packet pick-up beginning at 7:00AM Knoch High School.
- T-Shirts & Prizes** 100% polyester performance fabric T-shirt guaranteed to first 150 pre-registered runners. Remaining T-shirts on a first-come/first-serve basis. A pair of technical socks for all runners who pre-register for the Distance Series. **Refreshments and drawing for prizes immediately after the race.** Prizes include: **two Club-level tickets to Steelers vs. Bills preseason game.**
- Directions:** *From Pittsburgh:* Follow Rt. 8 North to Dinnerbell Rd. (Approx. 2 miles past Rt. 228 East); Turn right onto Dinnerbell Rd; Go approx. 5 miles and turn right onto Knoch Road; Knoch High School is on the right). *From I-79 and places north:* Take I-79 South to Rt. 422; Follow Rt. 422 East to Rt. 8 Butler; Take Rt. 8 South to Dinnerbell Road; Turn left onto Dinnerbell Rd; Follow directions above.
